The X-Change Tour '02 is an ongoing continuation of the 2001 project X-Change: No Money Involved (Project 03) at the Kupittaa Railway Station. This time Iconoclast wanted to test the shelving in a more closed environment to see, if the anonymous bartering would be accepted as a new method of social interaction. Stories and messages attached to the objects were now put on the foreground, too. For this purpose a special "Book of X-Changes" was designed, to function as a log of stories and memories for the users.

The tour launched at a service center for seniors - seniors have lots of time in their hands and lots of stories and memories to tell. Moreover, their time tends to be leisurely. That's why every new "social tool" is welcome to activate their bodies and minds. After two different centers for seniors, one for richer, one for poorer people, the X-Change shelving was tested in a more dynamic environment, a youth hostel.

Although the X-Change shelving's technical function remains the same, it nevertheless takes on new aspects every time it is introduced to a new social environment. This makes the tour format even more interesting: every user group has its own priorities and ways of dealing with new forms of interaction. Seniors see the shelving as entertainment: the shelving is always in a state of flux which makes it a "news item" - they come often to check if something has changed. Youth, however, take a more pragmatic approach: they check the things they like or need and dump useless stuff. What is common to both groups is the reluctance to leave messages. For Iconoclast this is the greatest challenge: how to create a social tool that would be able to mediate stories anonymously in an easy-to-use format. The project is in process and as new experiences cumulate, Iconoclast tries to adapt to the special needs of people and to develop an even more readily accepted form of interaction.
